RAVE Foundation is the official charitable arm of Seattle Sounders FC. Its mission: To build small, accessible soccer fields in urban areas that provide free play to shape young citizens, strengthen communities and encourage physical activity.

The RAVE Foundation has three core strategies:

- To use soccer as a vehicle to empower and inspire;
- To remove barriers to participation on and off the field
- To support, catalyze and strengthen communities. By building small fields, the RAVE Foundation provides a place for kids to play freely, be physically active and safe, and to be inclusive stakeholders in their communities.

2016 Accomplishments:

- Launched RAVE Foundation as the official charitable are of Seattle Sounders FC
- Donated 1000 match tickets to underserved youth and families in the Puget Sound region
- Donated 500 high quality soccer balls to kids in our RAVE target communities
- Hosted 7 pop-up soccer experiences with the RAVE octagon in RAVE target communities
- Granted funds to partner programs that align with RAVE’s core strategies:
 - Latino Community Fund
 - America SCORES
 - YouthCare
 - Washington Youth Soccer/Soccer for Success
- Hired a full time Executive Director
- Enacted a RAVE awareness/messaging campaign using social media and email marketing tools during the 2016 playoffs and through December, capitalizing on Sounders FC’s MLS Cup Championship
- Partnered with glassybaby Seattle on a cause marketing campaign, receiving proceeds for all sales in the month of Seattle
